


QUESTION OF THE WEEK, WEEK 18 (3–7.5.2023)

NUMBER OF RESPONDENTS: 474

The margin of error is 4 % and thereby the answers are considered to reflect the opinions of the population in Jakobstad.

CONTROL OF HARMFUL PLANTS

This week's question was about invasive plants, and the residents were able to answer if they knew that there are Garden Lupin and Himalayan Balsam growing in their area.



The respondents then were asked where. We received 234 answers and most of the respondents gave specific places in Jakobstad, and the information has been sent to the town's Environmental Protection Office.

We also asked about the resident's interest in participating in **an information event and/or collective work (sv. talko/fi. talkoot)** for controlling Garden Lupin and Himalayan Balsam. **22 percent (104 respondents) were interested** and 75 of these wanted to participate in an information event and 64 in talkoot.

The residents were further asked if they have heard about the nature conservation project PIA – Invasive Plants in the Jakobstad region 2022–2024. 32 percent (152 respondents) had.
