The margin of error is 6 % and thereby the answers are considered to reflect the opinions of the population in Jakobstad quite well.

THE CULTURAL PEARL JAKOBSTAD

In the Question of the Week the residents were asked: *"The town is going to apply for an international project. The project is looking for small towns in the Baltic Sea Region that actively want to develop their town in interaction together with its residents. The project is especially focused on local assets of culture and creativity. The town of Jakobstad is now looking for ideas on how to make the town centre a creative living room that is rich in culture for all its residents. How would you create it?"*

The question was harder than usual and quite demanding for the respondents. This might be a reason to why the number of respondents was considerably lower than in previous surveys, which was to be expected.

The residents were also asked: *"If the town qualifies for the second round, would you be interested in hearing more about this?"* 160 people answered Yes and 124 people also gave their contact details.
