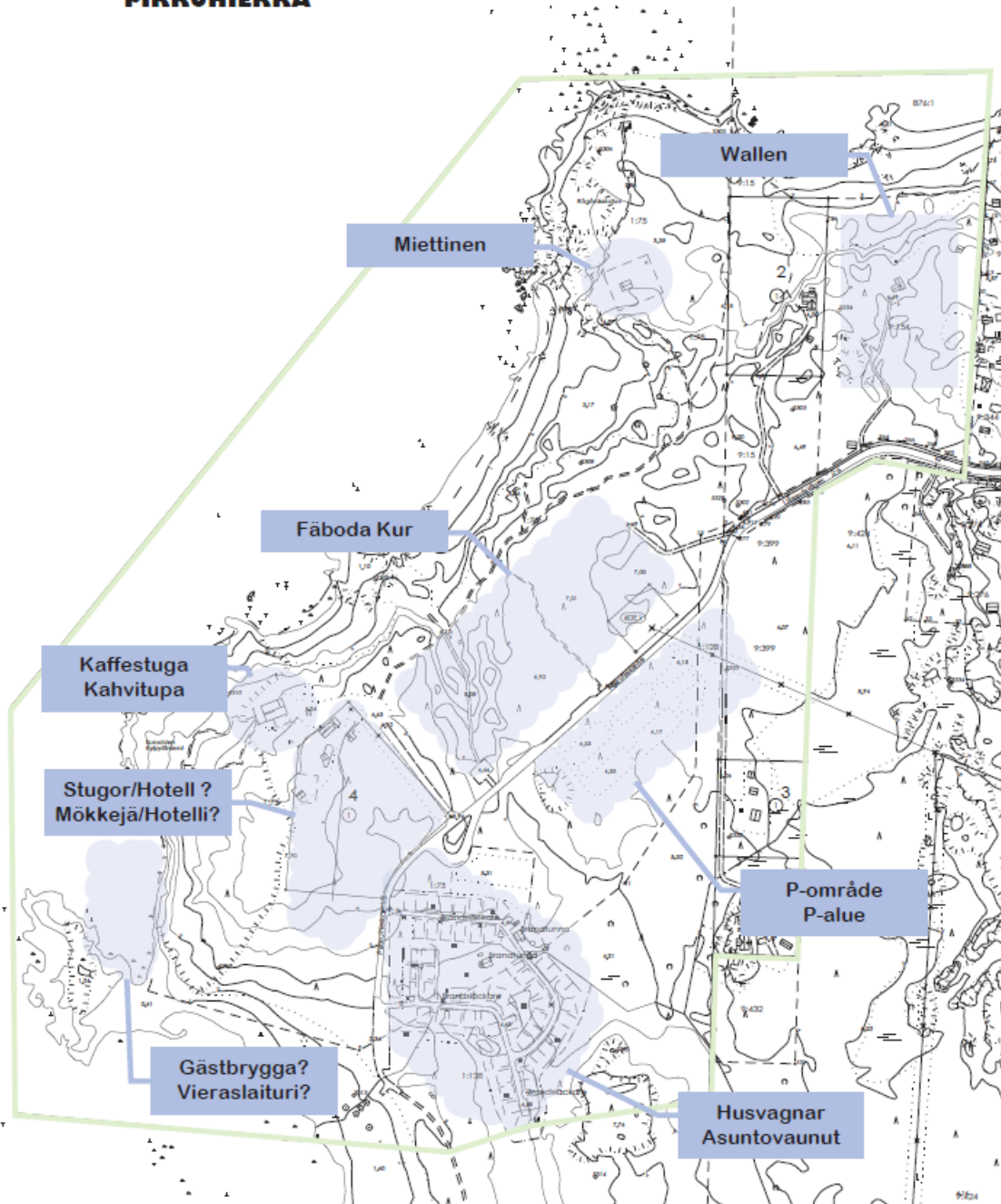


QUESTION OF THE WEEK, WEEK 36 (6-10.9.2023)

THE LOCAL DETAILED PLAN FOR FÄBODA

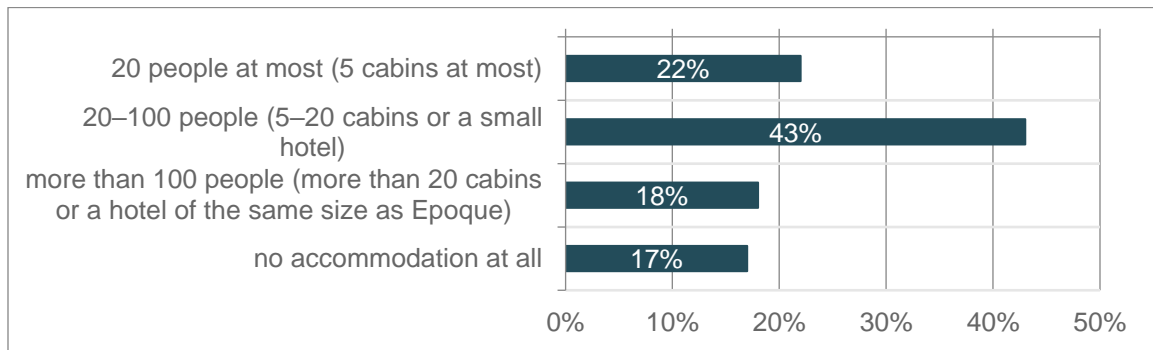
In the Question of the Week the residents were asked: *“The local detailed plan for Fäboda is outdated and the work of renewing it has begun. In the plan it is foremost decided what areas are used for different purposes, the extent and method of building, and which areas, where building is not wanted, are to be protected.*

It is not a completely blank canvas, since there are quite a few boundary conditions that direct the planning – among other things, the obligation to protect valuable nature sites such as open cliffs, sand dunes, and valuable forest types.

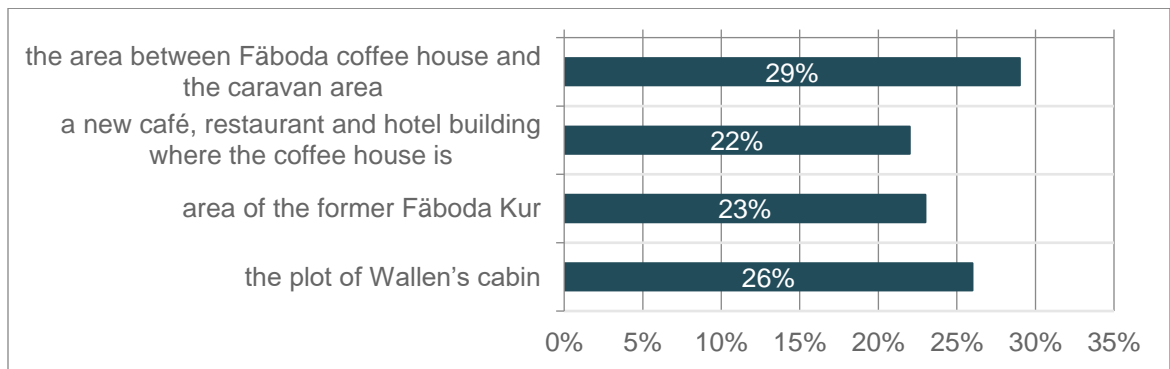
To achieve a plan that makes it possible to develop Fäboda in a way that at least most people hopefully can accept, it is important that all who are interested in the area can participate in choosing functions and their dimensions. This is partly done through this survey.

In the attached map the areas that have a key position regarding their function are marked. Reflect on the matter, both with heart and mind.

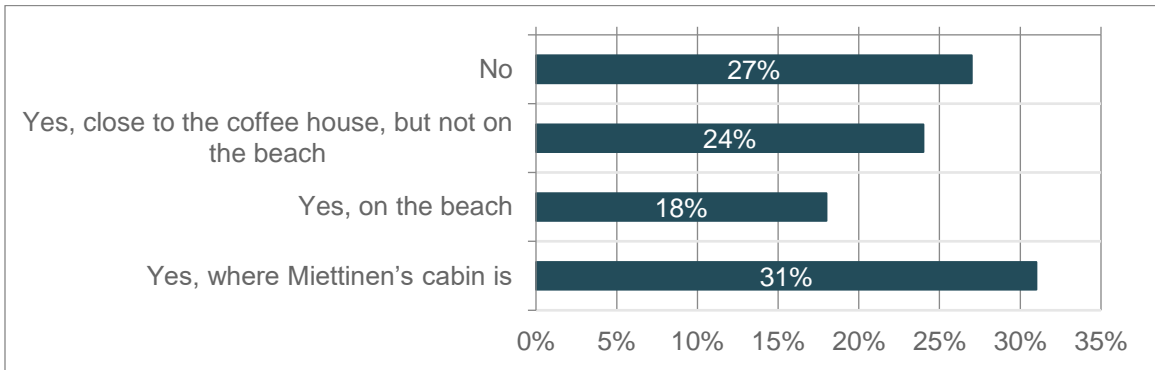
How big accommodation capacity would you accept in Fäboda?”



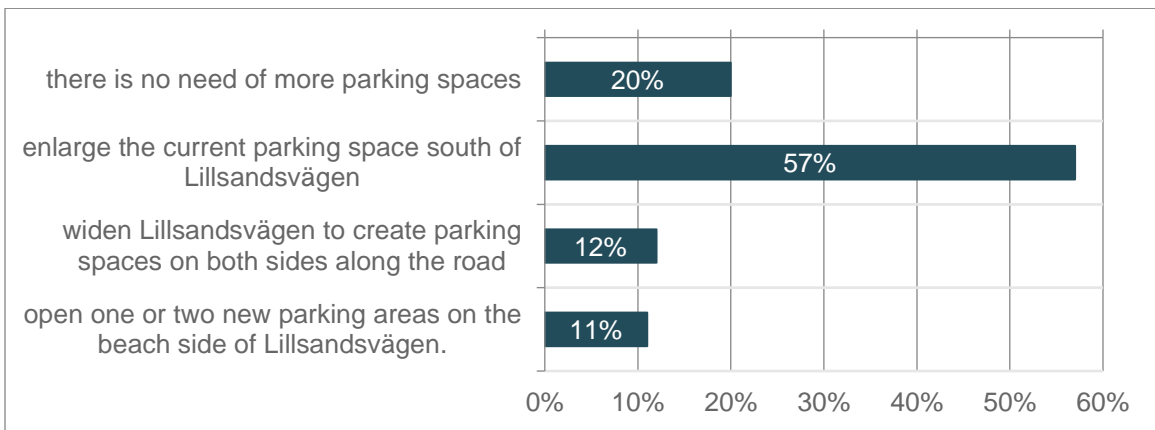
If you accept building of a hotel or cabins, where could the location be?



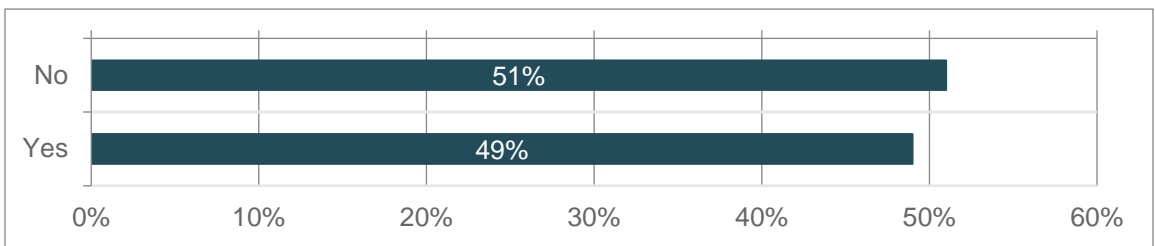
Can a public sauna be built in Fäboda, where?



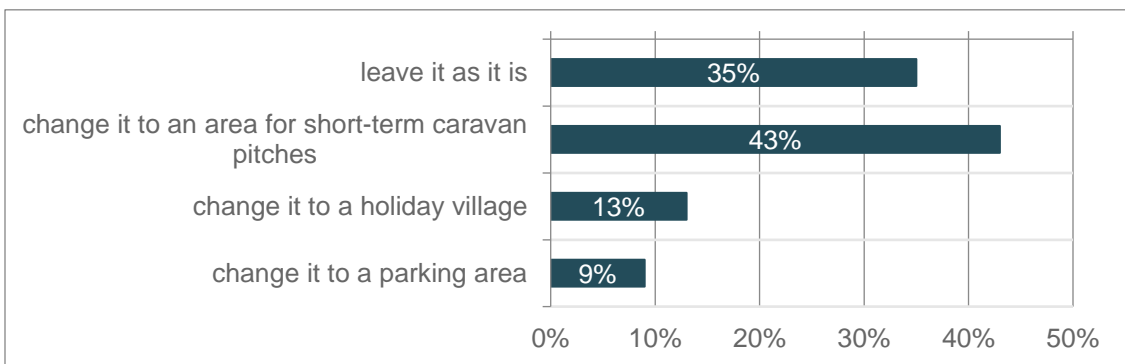
Is there a need of more parking spaces in Fäboda? If yes, where would you place them?



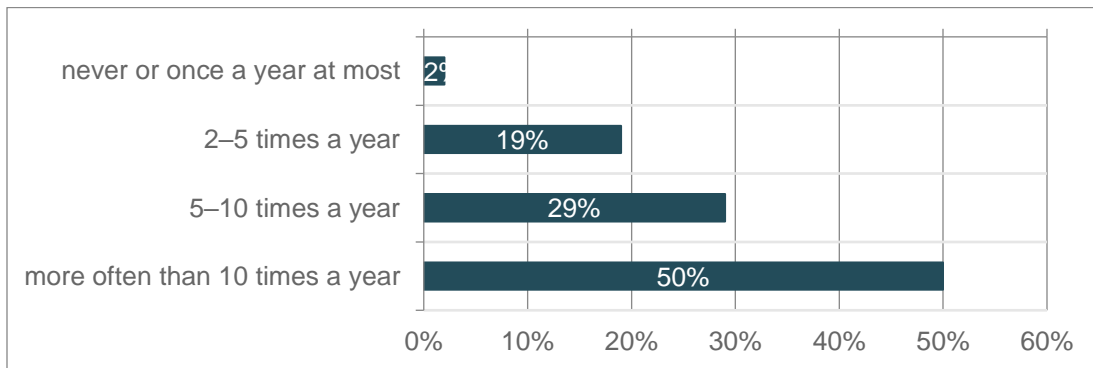
Is there a need for a guest harbour for small boats?
